What are the Providence Family STEM Camps?

The all new Family STEM Camp at Providence is an opportunity for one parent accompanied by up to two children to experience four separate weekend morning learning sessions together. Participation is limited to 28 total people. Three of the four sessions will be held on the Providence High School campus, while the fourth will involve a road trip for some fossil hunting in Southern Indiana.
