The Lady Pioneers were back to back sectional and regional champs in 2015-16. From 2014-20 the Lady Pioneers have been one of the top programs in Indiana and have the highest win total in Clark and Floyd County during that span. Coach Burden has coached at the AAU, high school, college, and semi-pro levels. In 17 years of coaching high school basketball, Coach Burden has coached 8 players who have gone on to play in college and three 1000 pt scorers in the past 5 years.
