

# Virtual Parent-Teacher Conferences

October 18-25, 2021

Providence High School will hold **Parent-Teacher Conferences** virtually this year the week of October 18-25. These conferences will give you an opportunity to gather more information concerning your son or daughter's academic progress in their classes. We are asking that these conferences be reserved for parents who want to talk with teachers if their son/daughter is struggling academically and/or having difficulty with the class.

These conferences can be set up in three different formats: email, phone, or videoconference. To schedule a conference, you will need to email the specific teacher (first initial, last name @providencehigh.net) requesting a conference. *In person conferences can be arranged if the parent(s) and/or teachers believe that this method would be a more effective means of communication.*

Within 48 hours of the request, the teacher will be in contact with you to determine the format, date, and time.

In addition to communicating with your student's teachers, you also have the opportunity to be in contact with our **Guidance Department and Learning Support** for a conference if needed. You should follow the same procedure as with the teachers to schedule a conference.
